

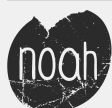

STANDARD BOARD

Mini Simmons



A short, wide board designed to be simple, fast, and fun in many conditions.

Despite its compact size, it paddles well and catches waves easily thanks to its width and volume. Once on the wave, it builds speed quickly and glides smoothly through flatter sections. The twin fin setup keeps it fast, lively, and easy to flow through turns.

Its bottom shape combines a slight belly in the nose, concave through the middle, and a subtle V in the tail — helping the board generate speed, stay smooth, and turn easily from rail to rail.

STANDARD BOARD

Keel Fish



A fast, flowing board inspired by the traditional fish.

Its wide outline and swallow tail create excellent speed and glide, especially in weaker or slower waves. It catches waves easily, carries speed naturally, and feels smooth down the line. The twin keel fins give strong drive and projection, making the board ideal for long, flowing turns rather than tight vertical surfing. It usually works best around 4–8 inches shorter than your height.

STANDARD BOARD

Modern Fish



Keeps the speed and glide of a traditional fish, but with a more versatile and performance-oriented feel.

Its outline is slightly longer and narrower, with more curve through the tail. This helps the board fit into tighter pockets and handle steeper or more powerful waves, while still keeping the easy speed of a fish.

It paddles well, catches waves early, and generates speed with little effort. The twin fin setup gives drive and projection while keeping the board loose and responsive.

STANDARD BOARD

Twin



Short, fast, and lively — designed for surfers who want speed, freedom, and a more performance-oriented feel.

It carries generous volume for its length, helping with paddling and early wave entry while staying responsive and easy to surf.

The clean outline and slightly pulled-in tail give more hold and control in punchier waves. Combined with the twin fin setup, it offers strong drive, speed, and a loose, flowing feeling through turns.

STANDARD BOARD

Almond



A simple, versatile board designed to make surfing easy, stable, and enjoyable.

With its generous volume, balanced outline, and smooth curves, it paddles well, catches waves early, and feels comfortable under the feet. It is very beginner-friendly, but still responsive enough to keep progressing for years.

Its fuller outline and rounded rails give it a forgiving feel, while the moderate length makes it easier to carry, store, and travel with than a classic longboard.

STANDARD BOARD

Midlength



A versatile board for smooth, flowing surfing in many conditions — the paddle power and glide of a longer board with the manoeuvrability of a shorter shape.

Its balanced outline gives stability, easy wave entry, and smooth rail-to-rail turns. It catches waves easily, builds speed naturally, and feels comfortable in both small waves and more powerful surf.

The closest thing to a one-board quiver. Ride it as a single fin for a loose, flowing feel, or as a 2+1 for more control in bigger or steeper waves.

STANDARD BOARD

Midlength Twin



A simple, balanced board designed for everyday surfing.

It paddles easily, catches waves early, and still turns smoothly from the rail. Its clean, stable outline helps the board build speed naturally and draw long, flowing lines.

It shares the same shape as the Midlength 2+1, but the twin fin setup gives it a faster, looser feeling with more drive and freedom through turns.

STANDARD BOARD

Displacement Hull



Designed for a different kind of surfing: flow, trim, and connection.

Instead of sharp turns or quick direction changes, it prefers clean lines, rail engagement, and careful positioning on the wave.

The belly bottom moves through the water rather than simply planing on top of it, creating a smooth, fluid feeling that only a displacement hull can offer. Once set on rail, the board builds and carries speed with very little effort.

LONGBOARD

Mini Glider



A long, elegant board designed for glide, trim, and effortless speed.

Inspired by traditional gliders but slightly shorter, it keeps the smooth glide and paddle power of a long board in a more practical size. It is called "mini" because it offers the feeling of a glider, not because it is small.

Once on the wave, it builds speed naturally and carries momentum through flatter sections with very little effort. Beautiful in smaller, clean waves, but it handles larger surf too.

LONGBOARD

Everyday Longboard



Made for surfers who want one longboard for a wide range of waves and conditions.

Stable, smooth and easy to paddle, it catches small waves early and gives that classic longboard glide from the first strokes. Its refined outline, narrower tail and balanced rocker also make it comfortable when the waves get steeper.

Not a pure performance longboard, and not a heavy traditional log either. It sits in between: easy to ride, versatile, and responsive enough to turn with control.

LONGBOARD

Noserider



A classic longboard designed for trim, glide, and time spent on the nose.

Its full, balanced outline gives excellent stability and makes it easy to walk the deck. The square tail creates a solid pivot point, helping you turn smoothly from the tail and set the board in the pocket before moving forward.

A spoon in the nose creates lift for noseriding, blending into belly through the middle for a smooth, forgiving feel. Soft 50/50 rails help the board sit comfortably in the water while trimming.
